THE ISLAND AT THE BACK OF BEYOND? ECONOMY AND SOCIETY OF THE BALEARIC ISLANDS IN THE BRONZE AND EARLY IRON AGE

The lecture introduces into the habitat, the resources and the archaeological landscape during the change from the Bronze to the Iron Age (1.500 - 500 BC) on the Balears. The detailed study of the archaeological record and new results on the metallurgic development permit the prospect on social changes.
